ID AYU0259) with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 41 seats (instead of 42 seats) in 07 PG courses in the subject namely i) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhant – 06 seats, ii) Rachna Sharir –05 seats (instead of 06 seats), iii) KriyaSharir – 06 seats, iv) Kayachikitsa – 06 seats, v) Prasuti & Stri Roga – 06 seats, vi) Shalyatantra – 06 seats, vii) Kaumarbhritya – Bala Roga – 06 seats for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder with respect to appeal dated 15.10.2025 –regarding.**

Sir/Madam,

1. This is with reference to your first appeal filed by the Principal, Shri Anand Niketan Dharmshala Avom Dharmik Trust, Shri Dhanwantri Ayurvedic Medical College & Research Centre 27 k.m milestone, Mathura-Delhi Highway Mathura NH-19, Chhata, Mathura, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0259) vide letter no. SDAMCRC/Q-14945/2025 dated 15.10.2025 to the Commission against the Yearly Permission with seat reduction in PG issued to Shri Anand Niketan Dharmshala Avom Dharmik Trust, Shri Dhanwantri Ayurvedic Medical College & Research Centre 27 k.m milestone, Mathura-Delhi Highway Mathura NH-19, Chhata, Mathura, Uttar Pradesh (AYU0259) with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 40 seats (instead of 42 seats) in 07 PG courses in the subject namely i) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhant – 06 seats, ii) Rachna Sharir –05 seats (instead of 06 seats), iii) Kriya Sharir – 06 seats, iv) Kayachikitsa – 05 seats (instead of 06 seats), v) Prasuti & Stri Roga – 06 seats, vi) Shalyatantra – 06 seats, vii) Kaumarbhritya – Bala Roga – 06 seats due to non fulfillment of the basic eligibility criteria in terms of NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals) Regulations, 2024 and Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda Regulations 2024", and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder and other shortcoming as mentioned in **Yearly Permission in UG & Yearly Permission with seat reduction in PG** letter of even no. dated 14.08.2025.
2. The submission made by the **Prof Saurabh Kumar, Officiating Principal of the college** was placed before the Chairman, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine and it has been decided by the Chairman, NCISM to consider the appeal on the basis of availability of 02 Professor and 01 Associate Professors in Kayachikitsa Department for Grant of Yearly Permission to **Shri Anand Niketan Dharmshala Avom Dharmik Trust, Shri Dhanwantri Ayurvedic Medical College & Research Centre 27 k.m milestone, Mathura-Delhi Highway Mathura NH-19, Chhata, Mathura, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0259) with 41 seats (instead of 42 seats) in 07 PG courses in the subject namely i) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhant – 06 seats, ii) RachnaSharir –05 seats (instead of 06 seats), iii) KriyaSharir – 06 seats, iv) Kayachikitsa – 06 seats, v) Prasuti & Stri Roga – 06 seats, vi) Shalyatantra – 06 seats, vii) Kaumarbhritya – Bala Roga – 06 seats** as per the concerned acts & regulations for the academic session 2025-26.

3. Further, the Chairman, NCISM directed the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM vide letter no. 51-89/2025-26/Comm. Appeal/College (Ayu.) dated 30.10.2025 to grant Yearly Permission to **Shri Anand Niketan Dharmshala Avom Dharmik Trust, Shri Dhanwantri Ayurvedic Medical College & Research Centre 27 k.m milestone, Mathura-Delhi Highway Mathura NH-19, Chhata, Mathura, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0259) with 41 seats (instead of 42 seats) in 07 PG courses in the subject namely i) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhant – 06 seats, ii) Rachna Sharir –05 seats (instead of 06 seats), iii) KriyaSharir – 06 seats, iv) Kayachikitsa – 06 seats, v) Prasuti & Stri Roga – 06 seats, vi) Shalyatantra – 06 seats, vii) Kaumarbhritya – Bala Roga – 06 seats** for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 as per the concerned acts & regulations.

**"DECISION"**

4. Therefore, in view of above, **Shri Anand Niketan Dharmshala Avom Dharmik Trust, Shri Dhanwantri Ayurvedic Medical College & Research Centre 27 k.m milestone, Mathura-Delhi Highway Mathura NH-19, Chhata, Mathura, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0259) is hereby granted with :-**
- a) **Yearly Permission in 07 PG courses with intake capacity of 41 seats (instead of 42 seats) in the subjects namely i) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhant – 06 seats, ii) RachnaSharir –05 seats (instead of 06 seats), iii) KriyaSharir – 06 seats, iv) Kayachikitsa – 06 seats, v) Prasuti & Stri Roga – 06 seats, vi) Shalyatantra – 06 seats, vii) Kaumarbhritya – Bala Roga – 06 seats in accordance with Regulation 15(7) of NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulation, 2024 as per the available teacher-student ratio, under section 28(1)(f) of NCISM Act, 2020.**
5. **The aforementioned decision is issued under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that following requirements shall be fulfilled:-**
- (i) **It is further informed that minimum 15% of postgraduate seats with intake capacity of 41 seats [instead of 42 seats] in 07 PG courses shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations there under.
7. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
8. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
9. You are hereby instructed to comply with all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide. ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS. Dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.
10. **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2025 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-27 :-**
- i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.

- ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
  - iii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulations, 2024.
  - iv) All the requirement of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standard of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022.
11. In case if you are not satisfied with the decision of Commission, NCISM, you may prefer 2<sup>nd</sup> appeal to the Central Government addressed to the Secretary, Ministry of Ayush, Ayush Bhawan, B Block, GPO Complex INA, New Delhi-110023 within 15 days of issuance of the letter.
12. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2025-26.
